unfolds dramatically, engaging you in its own distinctive and colorful personality.

Brennan's pink stucco façade remains unchanged, an iconic landmark on Royal Street welcoming new generations of patrons. Its particular pink has an Old World, old-fashioned glamour, and it pops up as a light-hearted accent in a number of the re-designed rooms. Langham created a fantasy of

'New Orleans French' style, but also pays homage to the history of Brennan's, itself, a place that has meant so much to so many southerners.
